


e-Learning Platform

The platform has been developed as an interstellar adventure! The participant will have to overcome missions on 5 planets to obtain a passport that will allow them to return to Earth as an 'Inclusive Coach'.

Each planet explores different concepts closely related to the concept of social inclusion. Within each module there are different materials that will enable learning: videos, texts, links, tools and assessments. In addition, the platform is available in all languages of the Consortium.
